



Waste to Energy

Did you know Midwest Environmental Services, Inc. has a Waste to Energy program for non-hazardous waste materials that are commonly disposed of in Landfills?

Midwest Environmental Services, Inc. can manage an array of waste materials including filter cake sludges, contaminated soils and debris, latex paints, oil sludges, and manufacturing waste and debris. These materials, and many others, are then converted into an energy source such as electricity and steam. Midwest Environmental Services, Inc. can accept your liquid, sludge, or solid Waste to Energy materials in bulk or container quantities.

This process is commonly referred to as non-hazardous incineration. Our program is very cost competitive even when compared to landfill options. Incineration of your non-hazardous wastes has many benefits. The incineration process provides destruction of your waste and limits your liability by minimizing the amount of waste you ship to Subtitle D Landfills. The process also helps conserve natural resources by converting the Waste to Energy and reducing our reliance on fossil fuels. The typical Waste to Energy facility can utilize one ton of waste to replace one barrel of oil or a quarter-ton of coal.

Midwest Environmental Services, Inc. has a network of Waste to Energy facilities that all utilize state of the art technology that generates electricity and/or steam for use as an energy source at municipalities and private industry. All waste streams are carefully reviewed by our technical staff to determine the best options for inclusion in the Waste to Energy program.
