We at Midwest Environmental Services thoroughly scrutinize all waste disposal and recycling facilities. All electronics waste goes through a two-stage destruction and recycling process. Materials are processed through primary and secondary shredding operations, and then separated into metal and plastic components. Metal components are then smelted for recovery of metals and the plastics are ground for reuse. All of our recycling partners adhere to strict guidelines to ensure environmental compliance and data security.

Midwest Environmental Services tracks all shipments of electronics waste to ensure your materials are handled in the most secure and environmentally safe manner. Certificates of Destruction/Recycling are available for all of your waste materials upon request. In addition to electronics waste, our staff can help keep you “Green” by recycling any of the following wastestreams:

- Non-Ferrous and Ferrous Metals
- Plastics
- Mercury
- Chlorinated Solvents
